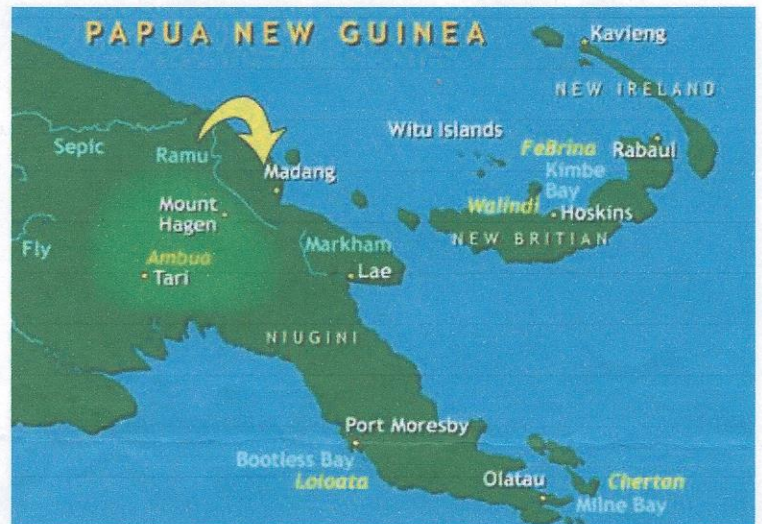
kitchen and also spending time with our guests.
